COUNTY:


AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT VICIOUS DOGS IN THE COUNTY
FROM RUNNING ASTRAY:

Section I: It shall be unlawful for any person to allow a vicious dog in the County of St. Francis to run astray. A vicious dog is defined as a dog which has bitten someone, or which displays a propensity to bite someone.

Section II: Any person found in violation of the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction be fined in any amount not less than \$5.00 nor more than \$500.00.

Section III: This ordinance being necessary for the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
